EHS PTSA Instructional Mini-Grant

Faculty Applicants who are currently members of the EHS PTSA may apply for the mini-grant program. Please consider your classroom instruction needs and submit this application to the PTSA mailbox by December 5th.

Applicants may be made by a teacher for a classroom or department. The PTSA Executive Board will make a selection based on innovative and creative teaching methods. Mini-Grants will be awarded through requisitions.

Please complete the following questions in detail. Incomplete applications will not be considered. We no longer pay the school for the entire amount of the mini-grant request, if approved. If the teacher orders a product directly from the company, we receive an order form and pay the company directly. If the teacher orders with a purchase order through the school, we pay the school back the exact amount once the product is received. All orders and reimbursements are to be made and received prior to the end of April of each fiscal school year.

At a minimum, please include the following information on your application: Applicant's name, Teaching position and level, department(if applicable), the exact amount of funds requested, the number of students that will benefit from the mini-grant proposal, and description of the project in detail for which this mini-grant is intended.
